COVID-19 2020-03-30 ORDINANCE UPDATE- 2021-03-18

As of March 17th, 2021

Chignik Lagoon Village Council has approved the following updates to the COVID-19 Travel Ban ordinance. We appreciate everyone (residents and non-residents) to follow the below guidelines to help prevent or spread the Covid-19 virus and to keep our village safe.

- At least 72 hours prior to flying into village, please notify Covid Coordinator or village office of your travels
- All people over the age of 16 need to be tested for Covid-19, 72 hours prior to arriving into Chignik Lagoon (village may require proof of test)
- Upon negative test result, people who are fully vaccinated (meaning at least 2 weeks has past since your second dose of Pfizer/Moderna or 2 weeks has past since 1 dose of Johnson and Johnson vaccine) do not need to quarantine (village may require proof of vaccine)
- People who are not fully vaccinated who have travelled need to quarantine along with their household for at least 14 days once arriving in village
- People who are fully vaccinated can gather indoors with other people who are fully vaccinated without wearing a mask. (Unvaccinated children may gather with vaccinated family pods at the discretion of the parents)
- Per CDC guidelines, it is still recommended to take precautions in public settings by wearing masks and staying 6-feet apart.
- Inner village travel is open if person is going by skiff or boat only between Chignik Lake or Chignik Bay

This ordinance update will be revisited again prior to the fishing season and/or as CDC updates recommendations.
