

Perryville IRA Health Mandate  
May 20, 2020

The Perryville IRA Council, the governing body for the federally recognized Native Village of Perryville, issues this health mandate to prevent the spread of the novel Coronavirus ("COVID-19"), a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death that is easily spread from person-to-person contact.

These precautions are necessary because of the high risk of infection to our Village elders, the bearers of our traditional knowledge, as well as to other tribal members and residents within our Village, and because of the inability to provide intensive medical care in the Village.

1. All persons traveling into the Village must self-quarantine within the residence for fourteen (14) days after arrival in Perryville. Travelers must wear a face covering or mask and observe social distancing while traveling. Any symptoms consistent with COVID-19 during this time (such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, loss of taste or smell, or any other symptoms listed on Attachment A) must be reported to the Council and the local health clinic.

2. Individuals must complete the Traveler Declaration and Checklist (Attachment A) and carry a copy during travel. Anyone experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19 listed on the Checklist is prohibited from traveling to the Village for a minimum of fourteen (14) days from the last symptom.

3. In addition, persons traveling into Perryville from communities with known COVID-19 cases must:

a. Undergo health screening and testing and submit the results to the Council. The person must have a negative test result within 48 hours of travel.

b. Submit the completed Traveler Declaration and Checklist (Attachment A) to the Council and the air carrier no more than twenty-four (24) and no less than sixteen (16) hours before travel. The person must attest that the person is not experiencing any symptoms on the checklist in order to travel to the Village.

c. The Council reserves the authority to determine whether a person who is not a resident of the Village may enter the village.


d. A person denied permission to enter the village may appeal the decision to the Council. The Council has final authority to determine if a person has provided sufficient evidence that the person has no signs or symptoms of COVID-19.

4. Air carriers must consult with the Council to confirm a person's eligibility to travel to the Village before transporting the person.


The Village Council is empowered by the Village Constitution, Traditional Law and Custom, and federal law to protect the general health, safety, and welfare of tribal members. The Council adopts this Mandate pursuant to the Village's inherent sovereign authority. This mandate supersedes all prior Health Mandates of the Native Village of Perryville (the "Village").

### Attachment A – Traveler Declaration and Checklist
