

Perryville Health Mandate

Updated April 8th 2021

The Perryville IRA Council, the governing body for the federally recognized tribe of The Native Village of Perryville, issues this Updated Mandate on 04-8-2021

Updated Covid 19 health mandate to prevent the spread of Covid 19, a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness and or death that is easily spread from person to person contact.

These precautions are necessary because of the high risk of infection to all village residents, and because of the inability to provide intensive medical care within the village.

- Wear a mask in public places
- Continue to practice social distancing
- Clean and sanitize yourself often
- Disinfect frequently touched objects

Fully vaccinated people upon arrival into Perryville from on or off the road system do not need to quarantine but should self-monitor for Covid 19 symptoms. Also it is recommended to get a Covid 19 test 5-7 days following arrival.

Regional Village travel is permitted by fully vaccinated people having proof of receiving Covid 19 vaccination. I.E (Vaccination Card provided by health officials or recovered covid patient who has a documentation from health officials)

For Fully vaccinated people please follow CDC Guidelines

Unvaccinated people shall show proof of a negative Covid-19 test prior to travel into Perryville. Those whom have travelled on or off the road system must quarantine the full 14 days along with their house hold upon arrival within the community. A Covid-19 Test is recommended 5-7 days following arrival.

The IRA Village Council is empowered by the Village constitution, Traditional Law and Custom, and federal laws to protect the general health, safety, and the welfare of resident tribal members. The Perryville IRA Council hereby adopts this Updated Mandate pursuant to the Villages inherent sovereign authority. This Updated mandate supersedes all prior Health mandates for of The Native Village of Perryville.
